- Mood disorders, anxiety disorders, stress and its management
- Psychiatric emergencies/crisis intervention
- Somatoform and sleep disorders, eat, sleep and sex disorder
- Personality disorders
- Disorder of infancy, childhood and adolescence
- Problems related to abuse, violence and neglect
- Legal issues in mental health nursing
