

EMT ADVANCED COURSE

After completing this program participants will be able to

- Administer appropriate emergency medical care based on the assessment findings of the patient's condition.
- Demonstrate the ability to perform clinical skills essential in providing basic emergency medical care services such as urgent need to respond the emergency calls, assurance of scene safety, precision to call other emergency people, handling different emergency scenarios from clinical emergency to trauma emergency to mass casualty to disaster management, etc.
- Demonstrate ambulatory setting up of emergency team
- Perform triaging and basic life support procedures
- Follow the concept of nursing process
- Practice infection control measures.
- Demonstrate appropriate and efficient communication with the team members and promote team work
- Demonstrate professional behavior, personal qualities and characteristics of a Emergency Medical technician-Basic
